1. Introduction

A cookie statement informs visitors about the use of cookies on a website. Cookies are small files that store information, such as preferences or browsing behavior. This statement explains which types of cookies are used, why they are necessary, and how users can manage their settings. Compliance with this statement is mandatory under privacy laws, such as the GDPR. By being transparent about the use of cookies, user privacy is protected, and legal compliance is ensured.

2. Cookie declaration

What is a cookie?

We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a small, simple file that is sent along with the pages of this website and stored on your computer's hard drive by your browser. The information stored in it can be sent back to our servers during your next visit.

User experience

To enhance your user experience on our website, we use Google's "Tag Manager," "AdWords," and "Analytics" services. These allow us to track statistics and generate reports on how visitors use our website. Cookies are placed via our website for this purpose. Google may share this information with third parties if legally required, or if third parties process the information on Google's behalf. We have no control over this. We have not permitted Google to use the collected information for other Google services.

Anonymity

The information collected by Google is anonymized as much as possible. Your IP address is explicitly not provided. The information is transferred to and stored on Google's servers in the United States. Google claims to adhere to the Safe Harbor principles and is a member of the Safe Harbor program of the U.S. Department of Commerce. This means that an adequate level of protection is in place for the processing of any personal data. You can opt-out of cookies being placed by Google and all its subsidiaries.
